List of Mandated Reporters

Anyone who has personal information about child abuse can report it to the Kalamazoo Child Protective Services, (269) 337-5046. *Some people are required to report by law, including:*

- Physicians
- Coroners dentists
- Registered dental hygienists
- Medical examiners
- Nurses
- Emergency medical care personnel (licensed)
- Audiologists
- Psychologists
- Marriage and family therapists
- Licensed professional counselors
- Certified social workers
- Social workers
- Social work technicians
- School administrators
- School counselors
- Teachers
- Law enforcement officers
- Regulated child care providers

State law requires: “Any of the professionals listed above, who has reasonable cause to suspect child abuse or neglect, shall make immediately, by telephone or otherwise, an oral report, or cause an oral report to be made, of the suspected child abuse or neglect to the Family Independent Agency - Child Protective Services. Within 72 hours after making the oral report, the reporting person shall file a written report [Michigan Form 3200]. Failure to report by those required can result not only in civil liability, but also criminal misdemeanor charges.”
